Leadership Northwest Missouri is signed up as a charitable organization that can obtain donations through Amazon.com. It is very simple and many people order through Amazon.com. We may as well try to get a percentage back for LNWMO.

How does my organization receive the donations?

Each quarter, the AmazonSmile Foundation makes donations to eligible charitable organizations by electronic funds transfer. Donations will be transferred approximately 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter. To account for Product returns, a portion of the quarterly donations will be withheld until the next donation cycle, subject to any reduction due to returns from prior quarters.

How does AmazonSmile work?

When first visiting AmazonSmile, customers are prompted to select a charitable organization from almost one million eligible organizations. In order to browse or shop at AmazonSmile, customers must first select a charitable organization. For eligible purchases at AmazonSmile, the AmazonSmile Foundation will donate 0.5% of the purchase price to the customer's selected charitable organization. This link will take people directly to <u>smile.amazon.com</u> in support of your organization so they won't have to search for your charity among almost a million other
